2016 JUNIOR WELSH OPEN

RULES

1. The tournament will be held at The Rhondda Bowl on Sunday 6th March 2016
2. The Junior Welsh Open 2016 is sanctioned by the TBAW. The general playing and tournament rules of the BTBA will govern this event, together with the following rules.
3. The event will be a H/C tournament with all bowlers providing proof of current league or tournament bowling averages.
Each bowler will bowl 9 games in blocks of 3 all in tournament format.
4. The event will be split into 3 categories based on age as of 1st September 2015.
 - A. U16's
 - B. U19's
 - C. U24's
5. Competitors must be registered with the TBAW or their own national association.
A £2 fine is payable for anyone who fails to produce a current membership card at registration.
6. The top 6 bowlers in each division will play a 5 game round robin to decide the overall winner. Qualifying scores will be brought forward and 20 bonus points for a win and 10 points for a draw will be added to each game.
7. In the event of a tie for any awarding placing, the higher score of the last game bowled shall determine the position. In the event of a further tie, the penultimate games will be compared.
8. All entries will be on a first come first served basis and the tournament manager reserves the right to reschedule or reject any entry.
9. Bowlers are requested to register 30 mins before their allocated squad time. Late players will commence at the frame in progress as directed by the tournament manager.
10. Protests of any nature must be logged with the tournament manager within 30 minutes of the infraction occurring and confirmed in writing before the presentation. A provisional ball must be bowled if a dispute regarding pinfall cannot be resolved immediately.
No protests will be accepted once the presentation has commenced.
11. Bowling shirts must be worn, casual shorts, combats, denim or jean style clothing is not allowed. Headwear is only allowed at the permission of the tournament manager, skirts and tailored shorts are permitted. Mobile phones are not allowed in the playing area.
12. The tournament manager will be as directed by the Chairman of the TBAW.
13. Prizes will be paid in the form of vouchers or bowling equipment in the U16's & U19's categories. Prizes in the U24's category will be paid in cash.
All prize monies will be returned 100% and will be allocated relative to the number of entries in each category. Prize fund distribution will be advertised in the centre for the duration of the tournament.
14. No competitor will be allowed to consume alcohol, smoke or use e-cigarettes during play. Any breach of this rule will result in immediate disqualification, as will bad language, gesticulation or equipment abuse.
